

Senior Citizens Assessment Freeze Homestead Exemption Outreach Sessions

March 14 and March 21, 2015

The Zion Township Assessor Larry Wicketts will be offering two public outreach sessions to assist Zion residents in completing the 2015 Senior Citizen Assessment Freeze Application for taxes payable in 2016; as well as service taxpayer needs on other homestead exemptions offered. The City of Zion residents will work one on one with a member of Mr. Wicketts' staff to complete any necessary exemption forms. Outreach will be held at Zion Township Assessors Office located at Zion City Hall.

➤ Qualifications are:

- 65 years old or older during the tax year
- Own the property as your principal residence for the last two Jan. 1 (2014 & 2015)
- 2014 total household income is \$55,000 or less

➤ Be prepared to bring copies of income received such as:

- 2014 Federal Income Tax Form
- Social Security Statement (SSA-1099)

➤ If the property is owned in a trust:

- Please bring in information providing proof of the beneficiary.
